## Care and support

Highwood Mill offers a range of support and care services aimed at ensuring that you are able to enjoy your home and life to the full.

A professional care team will be available on site 24 hours a day, seven days a week to provide commissioned care and support. Some people will need little or no support, while others may have higher needs including people with physical disabilities or dementia. Costs for care will depend on the level of help you need and your personal financial circumstances.

Our service managers ensure life at Highwood Mill runs as smoothly as possible. As well as being responsible for the management of the building and facilities, they play a key role in creating a friendly and welcoming community that we hope you will want to be a part of. The service manager will also visit you at home to give you support with anything from managing your paperwork, arranging appointments or just talking through any issues or concerns.

*Please note, while we aim to support your independence for as long as possible, there are upper limits to the amount of care and support that can be provided at Highwood Mill. Very occasionally, alternative accommodation may have to be arranged for a resident. This decision would be made by health and social care professionals in conjunction with the resident and family or an advocate acting on the resident's behalf.*

# THE LOCAL AREA

## On your doorstep

The historic market town of Horsham is a short distance from Highwood Mill and our shuttle bus means you will have no problem getting in and out of town.

Horsham is home to many restaurants, a museum, library, a thriving arts and cinema complex and you will always find lots going on in the town centre. There is a market every Thursday and Saturday and many events take place throughout the year. You will also find a good variety of shops including Sainsbury's, Waitrose and John Lewis. There are several GP surgeries, dentists and a leisure centre with large swimming pool.

Conveniently located across the main road (A24) from Highwood Mill via a wide pedestrian bridge is a Tesco Extra superstore; the shuttle bus will also run here regularly.

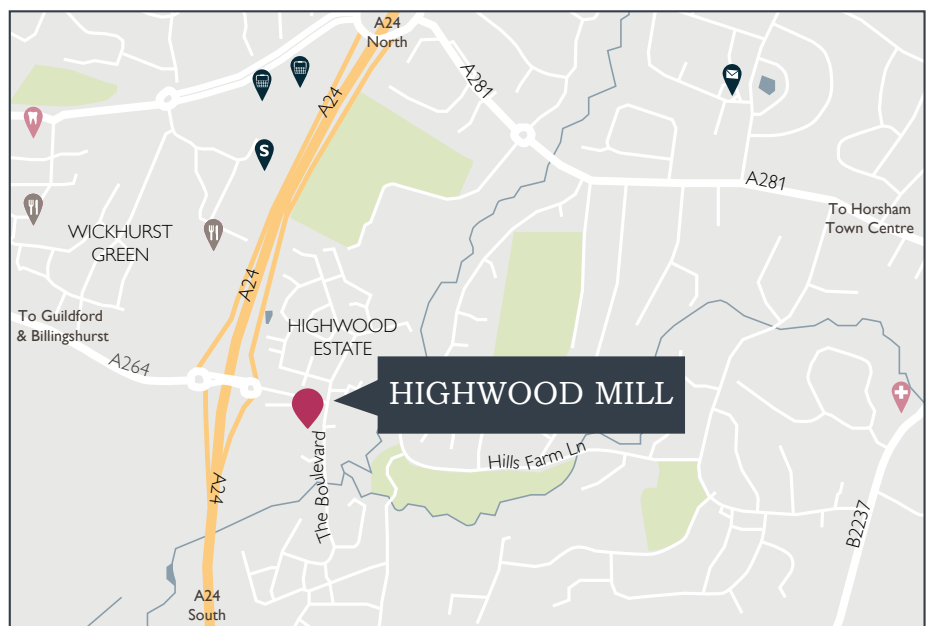
From Horsham there are excellent road and rail links to Brighton, London and Gatwick airport.

## Independent living

Our one and two-bedroom apartments are light and spacious, with many enjoying the added benefit of a private terrace or balcony. Each apartment at Highwood Mill is finished to an exceptional standard and neutrally decorated throughout.

The modern, fitted kitchens come complete with a fridge freezer and an integrated oven with hob and extractor fan. Bedrooms have a contemporary en suite which feature walk-in showers and can also be entered via your hallway.

A range of additional thoughtful touches aim to make daily living a little easier. These include raised-height electrical sockets to reduce bending. They also have a door entry system to enable you to let guests in from the main scheme entrance.

# APPLYING FOR A HOME



If you are interested in living at Highwood Mill, a member of our team will meet you to ensure that you are eligible and that your needs can be met by the scheme.

The scheme is mixed tenured, which means that some apartments are sold and others are rented. As in any community, there will be a mixture of owner occupiers and tenants. You do not need to have a care package to buy an apartment at Highwood Mill.

## Renting an apartment

If you are interested in renting at Highwood Mill, you must first contact the local authority to have your need for care assessed by the Adult Social Care team. Priority will be given to people with a local connection to the Horsham area. West Sussex County Council will then assess your eligibility for what care and support you can receive. Generally, you must be aged 55 or over and have demonstrated the need for care and housing support to be eligible.

## Buying an apartment

Some apartments at Highwood Mill are available to buy on the open market via local estate agents. Once you have shown interest in an available property, we will require contact to arrange an extra care assessment. We need to be sure that Highwood Mill is suitable in respect of any care needs you may have.

Apartments are sold on a leasehold basis. Saxon Weald, as landlord, is responsible for maintenance of the building and grounds. As leaseholder, you are responsible for your own apartment, including repairs and redecoration.

- Costs for meals or refreshments taken in the restaurant are payable separately.
- You are also responsible for paying your own council tax and home contents insurance.

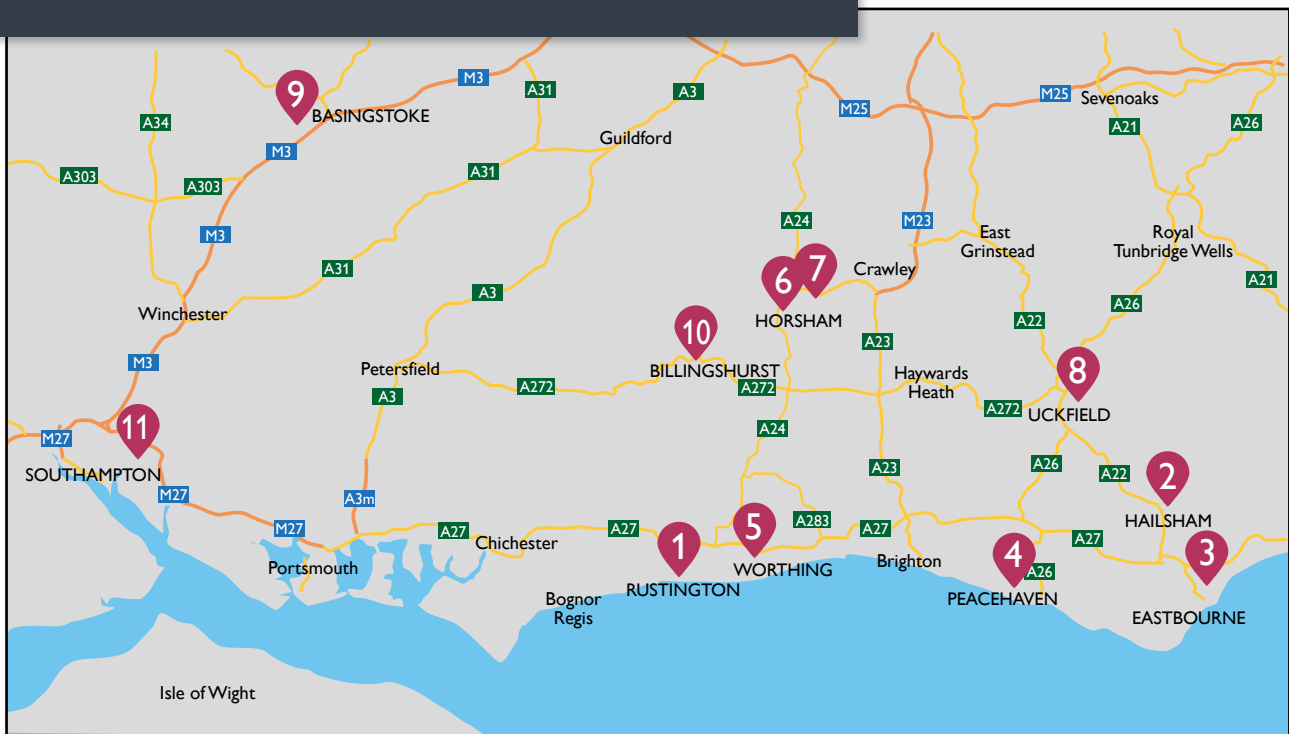

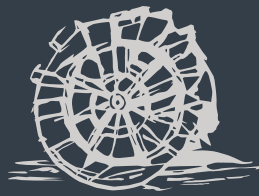
